### ORDINANCE 93-29

## TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAPS FROM RL to ML, GRANT PCD DESIGNATION, AND OUTLINE PLAN APPROVAL Re: 3111 Vernal Pike (Cowden Development, Petitioner)

### WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ML/PCD-38-93 and recommended that the petitioner, Cowden Development be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps, PCD designation, and outline plan approval and request that the Common Council consider his petition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RL to ML for the property located at 3111 Vernal Pike. That property is further described as follows:

A part of the north half of Section 31, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, Bloomington Township, Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows: COMMENCING at the Northwest corner of said half section; thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East along the North line of said half section 1320 feet to the point of beginning; thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East along said North line 1096.55 feet; thence South 05 degrees 00 minutes 50 seconds West 250.96 feet; thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 1074.62 feet; thence North 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East 250.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 6.23 acres, more or less.

SECTION II. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 and pursuant to Chapter 20.13 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, that an outline plan be approved and that the property described be designated a PCD.

SECTION III. The Outline Plan shall be attached and made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
