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ORDINANCE 91 - 47 To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps Re: Prospect Hill Lot #8

Prospect Hill Lot #8, 325 S. Jackson Street, City of Bloomington, Monroe County.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
