

ORDINANCE 88-28

TO AMEND THE 1988 SALARY ORDINANCE FOR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES
OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,
MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

SECTION I. That from and after the 20 day of July, 1988, the following classified positions, salaries and pay schedule be incorporated into Section I. of Ordinance 87-35, fixing the salaries of appointed officers and employees of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana:

ADD:	Frank Southern Center Recreation Manager	\$20,000

SECTION II. That from and after the 20 day of July, 1988, the following classified positions, salaries and pay schedule be incorporated into Section II of Ordinance 87-35, fixing the salaries of appointed officers and employees of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana:

ADD:	19	Frank Southern Center Recreation Manager	\$20,000

SECTION III. The rate shown as wage and salary for the positions listed above is the maximum rate.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
