ORDINANCE 88- 45

To Amend Title I of the Bloomington Municipal Code Entitled "General Provisions" and To Amend Title 15 of the Bloomington Municipal Code Entitled "Vehicles and Traffic"

WHEREAS, several acts deemed to be violations of the Bloomington Municipal Code can occur more than one time in any calendar day;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana that:

SECTION I. Section 1.01.130 (last sentence) be amended to read as follows:

Except for those violations which, by their very nature, can occur more than once in one day, each day that a violation continues shall constitute a separate violation.

SECTION II. Section 15.32.090(c) shall be added to read as follows:

After the maximum time limit has expired, a separate additional violation occurs for each period of time equal to the maximum time limit for which the vehicle remains parked in the limited parking zone to which the limit applies.

SECTION III. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval by the Mayor.
