SYNOPSIS

The General Fund (Public Works) portion of this Ordinance appropriates the County's contribution to the Tox-Away Day program.

Additional funds are needed in the Local Road & Street Fund for (1) purchase of right-of-way in conjunction with the Second & High intersection improvement project; (2) installation of underground conduit and foundations for future traffic signal projects at Old 37 and N. Walnut, W. Third and Madison, College Mall Road and Eastland Plaza, and for the Henderson/Winslow signal (scheduled for this simmer); (3) local match for installation of new traffic control devices and rubberized crossings at the Indiana Railroad crossing on W. Third St.; and (4) purchase of materials andd equipment for traffic signal installation of Henderson and Winslow.

An appropriation of funds in the Police Continuing Education Fund is needed to cover training costs for police officers. The Police Continuing Education Fund is funded by a \$3.00 charge collected when a defendant is in violation of a statute or local ordinance.
