

ORDINANCE 87-47

To Amend Title 6 of the Bloomington Municipal Code Entitled "Health and Sanitation".

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT THE FOLLOWING CHAPTER OF TITLE 6 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE SHALL BE ADDED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I.

Chapter 6.15

USED MOTOR OIL DEPOSITORY

6.15.010 Definitions.

(a) "Used motor oil" means any lubricating motor oil used in the crank case of an internal combustion or diesel engine. This does not include transmission fluid, brake fluid, anti-freeze, fuel oil, solvent, paint or lacquer, thinner, alcohol, or mineral spirits.

(b) "Used motor oil depository" means any barrel, container or other receptacle which the City designates as solely for the use of storing used motor oil.

6.15.020 Used Motor Oil Depository. The City may make available to the residents of the City a used motor oil depository. It is unlawful for any person to place any substance other than used motor oil into the used motor oil depository.

6.15.030. Depository Supervised by the Environmental Commission. All used motor oil accumulated in the used motor oil depository shall be disposed of by the City under the supervision of the Environmental Commission. The Commission shall have the authority to make regulations pertaining to the type and location of the depository, the hours during which the depository is available to the public, the disposal of the used motor oil and any other relevant matter as it finds necessary. The Commission may change or modify the regulations provided that any changes or modifications are not contrary to the provisions of this chapter.

6.15.040 Penalty. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this chapter shall be subject to a fine of not less than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for each violation.

SECTION II. Severability. If any section, sentence or provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions, or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this chapter are declared to be severable.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval by the Mayor.
