

ORDINANCE 85 - 6
To Amend the Zoning Maps from RH to RS
RE: (1800 Maxwell Lane, Bloomington Plan
Commission)

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, Z0-5-86, and recommended that the petitioner, The Bloomington City Plan Commission, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington Zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:


SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RH to RS for property located at 1800 Maxwell Lane and more particularly described as follows:

A part of Seminary Lot Number 134 in Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point 529 feet 2.5 inches East of the Northwest corner of said Seminary Lot Number 134 and on the South side of Maxwell Lane, thence East 66 feet, thence South 132 feet, thence West 66 feet, thence North 132 feet to the place of beginning.


Also, a part of Seminary Lot No. 134 in Monroe County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point 529 feet 2.5 inches East of the Northwest corner of said Seminary Lot No. 134, and on the South side of Maxwell Lane; thence running South 132 feet and to the real point of beginning; thence running East 66 feet to a point; thence running North 132 feet and to the South line of Maxwell Lane; thence running East along the South line of Maxwell Lane 66 feet to a point; thence running South 652 feet to a point; thence running West 132 feet to a point; thence running North 520 feet and to the real point of beginning, containing 1 - 4/5 acres, more or less.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
