ORDINANCE 86 - 45 To Vacate a Public Parcel RE: 400 E. Sixth Street (Trustees of RE: Indiana University)

WHEREAS,

IC 36-7-3-12 authorizes the Common Council to vacate public ways and places upon petition of persons who own or are interested in lots contiguous to those public ways and places;

WHEREAS,

the petitioner, Trustees of Indiana University, has filed a petition to vacate a parcel of City property at 400 E. 6th Street, and

WHEREAS,

IC 36-7-3-12 requires the Plan Commission to make a recommendation on the proposed vacation and to forward it to the Common Council; and

WHEREAS,

the Plan Commission has considered this petition and made a favorable recommendation on its adoption;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 36-7-3-12, a portion of City-owned property at 400 E. Sixth Street shall be vacated. The property is more particularly described as follows:

North-South alley between In-lots 242 and 243 more particularly described as: Beginning at the SE corner of In-lot 242; thence North 132 feet and to the NE corner of said In-lot 242; thence East 16 feet to the NW corner of In-lot 243; thence south 132 feet to the Southwest corner of said Inlot 243; thence west 16 feet and to the point of beginning.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council, approval by the Mayor, and published according to law.
