

RESOLUTION 86-32

Recommendations of Mayor for Distribution of the Additional Allocation
of Community Development Funds

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington, Indiana, is eligible for an additional allocation of Community Development Block Grant funds in the amount of \$109,000 for fiscal year 1986 pursuant to the Urgent Supplemental Appropriations Act of 1986; and

WHEREAS, the projected use of funds reflect programs recommended by the Mayor with input from the Workable Program Committee, the Human Resources Commission, and the Redevelopment Commission consistent with local and national objectives of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, THAT:

SYNOPSIS

The City of Bloomington has received an increase of \$109,000 to its fiscal year 1986 Community Development Block Grant of \$527,000 from the Department of Housing and Urban Development. The increase is due to the enactment of the Urgent Supplemental Appropriations Act of 1986 which disapproved the deferral of \$500 million in Community Development funds. This resolution outlines programs recommended for funding with the additional appropriation. The Mayor's recommendations are based on input from the Workable Program Committee, the Human Resources Commission, and the Redevelopment Commission.
