a strip of ground measured 9.15 feet along the entire east property line of In-Lot number 168, Section 33-T8N-R1W, Bloomington Township, Monroe County Indiana, lying between lines 30.00 feet and 80.00 feet north of the

south line of said Lot 168 and parallel thereto. SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council, approval by the Mayor,
