ORD I NANCE 85-28

AN ORDINANCE CREATING ADDIT ONAL CLASSES OF ANNUAL PARKING PERMITS AND MONTHLY PARKING PERMITS, DES-IGNATING THE HOURS OF OPERATION FOR PARKING METERS IN MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS, ESTABLISHING HOURLY PARKING CHARGE FOR SOME MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS AND DETERMINING FINES FOR MOST PARKING VIOLATIONS

- WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington is strongly committed to revitalization of the downtown; and,
- WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington has found that the lack of guaranteed, reserved parking spaces in the downtown area has served as a hindrance to development; and,
- WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington wishes to provide a greater inducement to revitalization of the downtown area by creating greater flexibility for parking;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, that:

SECTION 1. Section 15.40.030(a) and (b) of the Bloomington Municipal Code amended to read as follows:

15.40.030 - Parking Permits

- (a) The City will issue five types of annual parking permits.
 - (1) A limited number of annual parking leases, hereinafter referred to as Class A permits (not to exceed 25% of the available spaces) for specific spaces on the lower level of the Municipal Parking Garage are available. A limited number of annual parking leases, hereinafter referred to as Class A-3 permits (not to exceed 25% of the available spaces) for specific spaces in Lot 3 are available. A limited number of annual parking leases, hereinafter referred to as Class A-2 permits (not to exceed 25% of the available spaces) for specific spaces in Lot 2 are available. And, a limited number of annual parking leases, hereinafter referred to as Class A-5 permits (not to exceed 25% of the available spaces for specific spaces in Lot 5 are available. The charge for such annual parking leases in the Municipal Parking Garage and Lot 3 shall be Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per year, payable in advance. The charge for such annual parking leases in Lots 2 and 5 shall be Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per year, payable in advance. In addition, unlimited duplicate Class A, Class A-3, Class A-2, and Class A-5 permits shall be available to Class A, Class A-3, Class A-2 and Class A-5 permit holders, respectively at Five Dollars (\$5.00) per permit; each duplicate permit shall allow the permit holder to park an additional designated vehicle in the original Class A, Class A-3, Class A-2, or Class A-5 permit holder's specific designated stall only. No duplicate Class A, Class A-3, Class A-2, or Class A-5 permit-bearing vehicle may park in any other space or in any other lot, without proper permit for such lot. Only motor vehicles displaying a Class A, Class A-3, Class A-2, or Class A-5 permit or duplicate permit for that stall may park in a leased stall. Violators shall be ticketed and may be towed.
 - (2) Annual parking privileges, hereafter referred to as Class B permits, shall be made available for parking on a rental basis in any of the City parking lots, and in available spaces excluding those designated for Class A, Class A-3, Class A-2, and Class A-5 permits in Municipal parking lots. The charge for such privilege shall be One Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$170.00) per year, payable in advance.

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- (b) The City will issue one type of monthly parking permit.
 - (1) A limited number of monthly parking leases, hereafter referred to as Class M permits (not to exceed 100 parking spaces) for specific spaces in the Municipal Parking Garage are available. The charge for such spaces shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per month, payable in advance. In addition, unlimited duplicate Class M permits shall be available to a Class M permit holder at One Dollar (\$1.00) per permit; each duplicate permit shall allow the permit holder to park an additional designated vehicle in the original Class M permit holder's specific designated stall only. No duplicate class M permit-bearing vehicle may park in any other space or in any other lot, without proper permit for such lot. Only motor vehicles displaying a class M permit or duplicate permit for that stall may park in a leased stall. Any car illegally parked in a leased stall be ticketed and may be towed. المعادين والمحاج المراجع والمحاج والمحا
 - (2) The holder of a Class M permit may renew his permit on a monthly basis. The Class M permit holder shall be given the first option to purchase a monthly lease for the same specific space for the subsequent month, provided that he purchases the Class M permit after the first, but prior to the twentieth day of the preceding month. If the Class M permit holder has not exercised his option by the twentieth day of the month, the specific space may be leased to any individual who pays the Twenty-five Dollar (\$25.00) fee.

SECTION 2. Section 15.40.020(a) of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

The charge for the use of municipal parking lots 2, 4, 5, 6, and 8 and the municipal parking garage shall be five cents per thirtyminute period or part thereof, and ten cents per sixty minutes for the use of each space between the hours of seven a.m. and six p.m. every day except Sundays and national holidays. The charge for the use of municipal parking lots 1 and 3 shall be ten cents per thirty minute period or part thereof, and twenty cents per sixty minutes for the use of each space between the hours of seven a.m. and six p.m. everyday except Sundays and national holidays. The charge shall be collected by parking meters.

SECTION 3. Section 15.40.050(b) of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

No person shall park in a leased stall in the municipal parking garage, or Lots 3, 2 or 5, without a Class A, M, A-3, A-2 or A-5 permit sticker displayed in the lower right hand corner of the rear window of the vehicle, or in such other location designated by the City Controller.

SECTION 4. Section 15.40.050(f) of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall read as follows:

A parking permit shall be valid only if it is displayed in the lower right hand corner of the rear window of the vehicle, or in such other location designated by the City Controller.

SECTION 5. Section 15.40.060 of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall read as follows:

- (a) Any violation of this chapter, with the exception of a violation of Section 15.40.050(b) is a Class D Traffic Violation and subject to the penalty listed in 15.64.010(d).
- (b) Any violation of Section 15.40.050(b) is a Class F Traffic Violation and subject to the penalty listed in 15.64.010(g).

SECTION 6. Chapter 15.32 of the Bloomington Municpal Code shall be amended to <u>add</u> Section 15.32.185 as follows:

<u>Public Employee Parking.</u> The streets or parts of streets described in Schedule T, attached hereto and made a part hereof, are designated public employee parking zones. When appropriate signs are erected no person shall park a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts of streets unless that person has obtained a public employee parking permit, and has properly displayed said permit, as provided for by Chapter 15.38, Public Employee Parking permits.

SECTION 7. Title 15 of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to add the following new chapter entitled "Public Employee Parking Permits":

Chapter 15.38

PUBLIC EMPLOYEE PARKING PERMITS

15.38.010 Eligibility. Any person employed as an officer or official of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, or Monroe County, Indiana, or any agency, department or office thereof, who owns an automobile, may apply to the City Controller for a public employee parking permit for parking privileges on the streets or parts of streets designated within public employee parking zones, by Section 15.32.185.

15.38.020 Information required in application. The application form shall contain the name and address of the applicant and the applicant's employer and specific agency, department or office.

15.38.030 Display of permits. No person shall park on the streets or parts of streets designated as public employee parking zones without a public employee parking permit sticker displayed in the lower right hand corner of the rear window of the vehicle, or in such other location designated by the City Controller.

15.38.040 Expiration of permits. All permits expire on December 31st of year of issuance, or upon termination of employment, whichever comes first.

15.36.050 Issuance of permits. The application for a public employee parking permit shall be submitted to the City Controller, who shall issue a permit to the applicant.

15.38.060 Violation and penalty. Any violations of this chapter constitute a Class D Traffic Violation and are subject to the fines listed in Section 15.64.010(d).

SECTION 8. Sections 15.64.010(d) of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

(d) Class D Traffic Violations (Most parking violations)

Fine: \$5.00, \$10.00, \$15.00 (Depending on when paid)

SECTION 9. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect commencing September 1, 1985.

SECTION 10. <u>Severability</u>. If any section of this Ordinance or any part of any section shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions.

SYNOPSIS

This Ordinance creates five types of annual parking permits. The City will make permits available to lease specific spaces in the Municipal Parking Garage, and Lots 2, 3, and 5. In addition, the City will make annual parking privileges available for all Municipal parking lots and the Municipal Parking Garage. Also, the City will make monthly parking permits available to lease specific spaces in the Municipal Parking Garage. This Ordinance also increases the hourly charge for parking in Lots 1 and 3, increases the fine for most parking violations to \$5.00, \$10.00, or \$15.00, depending upon when paid, and increases the fine for illegal parking in leased spaces in Municipal parking lots. This ordinance also adds Chapter 15.38 entitled "Public Employee Parking Permits" Ord. 85-28
