## APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 85-3

To Specially Appropriate from the Parks and Recreation Fund Expenditures Not Otherwise Appropriated by the City of Bloomington

## SYNOPSIS

This appropriation ordinance provides for installation and operation of a water slide at Bryan Park Pool and for an energy audit of Frank Southern Center. The total amount of the water slide appropriation is \$26,125.00 with annual costs covered by generated revenues; the cost of the energy audit is \$10,000 with 50% of the cost provided by federal matching funds.
