

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-72-83, and recommended that the petitioner, BLOOMINGTON PACKING COMPANY, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from MG to ML for property located on Packinghouse Road, more particularly described as follows:

A part of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section thirty (30) Township nine (9) north range one (1) west bounded as follows to-wit: Beginning at a point two hundred (200) feet south of a stone that is twenty-five (25) chains and seventy six (76) links south and seven (7) chains and seventy six (76) links East of the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said section thirty (30) thence east three hundred (300) feet; thence south six hundred sixteen (616) feet to a hollow; thence west one hundred fifty four (154) feet; thence south one hundred twenty-nine (129) feet; thence west one hundred forty six (146) feet; thence north seven hundred forty-five (745) feet to the place of beginning and containing four and sixty-seven hundredths (4.67) acres, more or less. Also a part of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section thirty (30) and a part of the north east quarter of the northeast quarter of Section thirty-one (31) all in Township nine (9) north range one (1) west and described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point twenty-five (25) chains and seventy-six (76) links south of the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said Section thirty (30) same Township and range thence south one thousand two hundred forty-six (1246) feet to the center of the Vernal Pike Road, thence south fifty-nine (59) degrees, East six hundred sixteen (616) feet; thence north one thousand six hundred eight (1608) feet to a stone; thence west five hundred nineteen (519) feet to the place of beginning and containing seventeen (17) acres more or less, excepting from the above description a strip of ground thirty (30) feet in width off of the entire north side of the above described real estate, excluding all rights-of-way for the Highway 37 Bypass and all portions of the above legal description located east of the Highway 37 Bypass right-of-way.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
