## To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS,

the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS,

the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-3-83 , and recommended that the petitioner, Dr. W.C. Coleman be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from <u>BL (Limited Business) to SM (Special Medical)</u> for property located at <u>803 S. Rogers</u> more particularly described as follows:

Part of Seminary Lot Number Thirt-eight (38) in the City of Bloomington, Indiana, bounded and described as follows, to wit: Commencing at a point on the EAst line of Rogers' Street Pike Road where a line running due East and West Ten (10) poles and Ten (10) links South of the South line of Seminary Lot number Seven (7) in said City crosses said East line of said Pike Road; running thence due East one Hundred Fifty (150) feet; running thence South Three (3) rods and Four (4) links; running thence West to the center of the Pike Road; running thence North Three (3) rods and Four (4) links; running thence East to the place of beginning.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
