To Amend Section 20.04.01.00 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, Concerning Definitions of "Lodginghouses, Roominghouses" in Zoning Code

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 20.04.01.00 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled "Definitions", shall be amended to have the definitions of "Lodginghouse, Roominghouse" read as follows:

"Lodginghouse, Roominghouse" means a building with more than two guest rooms where lodging, with or without meals, is provided for compensation, or a single household dwelling occupied by more than five unrelated adult individuals, but not a hotel or motel.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
