## To Amend Section 15.72.040 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, Entitled "Parking Meters"

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 15.72.040 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled "Parking Meters;" shall be amended to read as follows:

In accordance with Section 15.72.020, parking meters shall be installed on the following streets or parts of streets in locations where parking is permitted:

Fourth Street from Madison Street to Lincoln Street Kirkwood Avenue from Madison Street to Indiana Avenue

Sixth Street from Madison Street to Lincoln Street

Seventh Street, from Rogers Street to Madison Street and from Morton Street to Washington Street

Eighth Street from Morton Street to Walnut Street Madison Street from Third Street to Seventh Street Morton Street from Kirkwood Avenue to Eleventh Street College Avenue from Second Street to Tenth Street Walnut Street from Second Street to Ninth Street Washington Street from Second Street to Seventh Street Lincoln Street from Smith Avenue to Sixth Street Grant Street from Fourth Street to Kirkwood Avenue Dunn Street from Third Street to Fourth Street Indiana Avenue from Third Street to Kirkwood Avenue

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
