

ORDINANCE 81-88

To Amend the 1980 and 1981 Salary Ordinances for
Utilities Employees to Add the Position of Maintenance Coordinator

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,
MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. From and after the 12th day of October, 1981, the following
classified position, salary and pay schedule for the Utilities Department be
incorporated into Sections I and II of Ordinance 80-71, Salary Ordinance for
the Utilities Department.

Section I. Treatment Operations

Maintenance Coordinator \$23,500

Section II. Pay Grade Classification Salary

28 Maintenance Coordinator \$23,500-\$26,300

SECTION II. From and after the 12th day of October, 1981, the following
classified position, salary and pay schedule for the Utilities Department be
incorporated into Sections I and II of Ordinance 81-77, Salary Ordinance for
the Utilities Department.

Section I. Treatment Operations

Maintenance Coordinator \$25,000

Section II. Pay Grade Classification Salary

26 Maintenance Coordinator \$24,750-\$26,000

SECTION III. The rate shown as wages and salary for the position listed
above is the maximum rate.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and
after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
