To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

Parcel A: A part of the Southeast quarter of Section 29, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana bounded and described as follows: beginning at a point that is 429.00 feet East and 175.00 Jeet North of the Southwest corner of the said Southeast quarter, thence Tunning South &9 degrees 56 minutes West for 267.00 feet parallel to the South line of the said Southeast quarter; thence running North for 163.15 feet; thence running North 89 degrees 56 minutes East parallel to said South line of quarter for 267.00 feet; thence running South for 163.15 feet and to the point of beginning.
