

RESOLUTION 81-22

To Accept the Action Recovery Program and Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan 1980-85 for the Parks and Recreation Department

WHEREAS, federal and state requirements provide that for a city to become eligible for Land and Water Conservation funds, it must adopt a master plan which sets the framework and provides guidance for the orderly expansion and development of a diverse and accessible parks systems; and
