

ORDINANCE 80-44

To Amend the 1980 Salary Ordinance to Reallocate the Position of Assistant Street Superintendent in the City of Bloomington's Position Classification Plan.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. From and after the fifth day of June, 1980, pursuant to IC 18-2-1-10, the following classified position, salary and pay schedule for Assistant Street Superintendent be deleted from Section II of Ordinance 79-55, Salary Ordinance for Appointed Officers and Employees of the City of Bloomington.




SECTION III. The rate shown as wages and salary for the position listed above is the maximum rate.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.




