

ORDINANCE 80-75

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, Z0-42-80, and recommended that the petitioner, Honeycutt & Hawkins, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RH (High Density Residential) to ML (Light Manufacturing) for property located at 800 East Thornton Drive more particularly described as:

A part of Lot Number Ninety-two (92) in BARCLAY GARDENS, being a sub-division of the West half of the Northeast quarter,

of Section Nine (9), Township Eight (8) North, Range One (1) West, and being described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Northwest corner of said lot; thence running in a Northeasterly direction on the North line of said lot for a distance of Sixty (60) feet; thence running South Two Hundred Eight and Five-tenths (208.5) feet, more or less, and to a point on the North boundary line of the property heretofore deeded to Oma Fulton and Sarah M. Brummett and Marion Brummett, her husband, which deed is recorded in Deed Record 83 at page 417 of the records of Monroe County, Indiana; running thence in a Northwesterly direction Sixty (60) feet along said boundary line to a point on the west line of said lot, Two Hundred (200) feet South of the Northwest corner thereof; thence North Two Hundred (200) feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

SYNOPSIS

This ordinance if approved will change the zoning from RH, High Density Residential, to ML, Light Manufacturing, for a parcel of .28 acres on the east side of Park Avenue south of Thornton Road. The petitioners, Berlin Hawkins and Lyander Honeycutt, intend to build an auto body shop. The ML zoning would also permit a broad range of uses, although the small size of the property will limit the possible scope of activity.
