

ORDINANCE 80-76

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, PUD-34-80, and recommended that the petitioner, James David Coffey, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed to Planned Unit Development designation and outline plan approval for property located at 900 North Curry Pike, Bloomington, IN more particularly described as:

Part of the West half of the Northeast quarter of Section 36, Township 9 North, Range 2 West, in Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the West line of said West half section where the same intersects the Southwesterly right-of-way line of the Chicago, Indianapolis, and Louisville Railroad; running thence South along said West line a distance of 1188.5 feet; thence East 600 feet, thence North 400 feet; thence East to the Southwest right-of-way line of said Railroad; thence in a Northwesterly direction along said right-of-way thereof with the West boundary line of said half section and to the point of beginning, containing 14½ acres, more or less.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
