

ORDINANCE 80-101

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and  
(Petitioners: Schlanbusch, Carlson, & Ruble)

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, HP-61-80, and recommended that the petitioner, (See above), be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RH to RH with Historical Designation for property located at 508, 514 & 522 North Washington Street more particularly described as:

- 508 N. Washington: Bollman's Addn. Lot 31
- 514 N. Washington: Bollman's Addn. Lot 29
- 522 N. Washington: Bollman's Addn. Lot 27

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
