Encomium for Betsy Williams, Grantsperson and Former Animal Shelter Director

- WHEREAS, Betsy Williams began working for the city in April, 1977 and served as the Animal Shelter Director until December, 1978, when she began serving as the City Grantsperson; and
- WHEREAS, under Betsy's directorship of the Animal Shelter, the city negotiated satisfactory contracts with the Humane Society and Monroe County after years of negotiations, the Animal Shelter was completely remodeled and expanded and its staff increased to become the City's first modern shelter, and the city's animal ordinances were updated and strengthened, resulting in accreditation of the Shelter by the Humane Society of the United States; and
- WHEREAS, as Grantsperson in the Controller's Office, Betsy helped implement a cost allocation plan for the city and worked to bring in nearly \$500,000 in grants during 1979, including an Urban Parks and Recreation Recovery Program grant for Crestmont Park, an Indiana Arts Commission grant for the city's sculpture project, and various transit subsidies; and
- WHEREAS, Betsy has performed all of her duties for the City with a high level of dedication and skill and has made numerous lasting contributions to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:
