## ORDINANCE 79-5

## To Amend Section 15.76.010 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, Entitled, "Stop Intersections".

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOM-INGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Subsection 15.76.010(3) of the Bloomington Municipal Code, "Three-Way Stop Intersections," shall be amended to delete the following:

Fifteenth Street and Indiana Avenue Henderson Street and Maxwell Lane

SECTION II. Subsection 15.76.010(1) "Stop Intersections Generally," shall be amended to add the following:

Indiana Avenue at Fifteenth Street Henderson Street at Maxwell Lane

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
