

ORDINANCE 79-9

Salary Ordinance for Appointed Officers and Employees,
To Fix the Salary of Legal Research Assistant for the
Common Council and to Delete Deputy City Clerk I from
the City Clerk's Budget

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,
MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

SECTION I. That from and after the *12th* day of February, 1979,
the salary and pay schedule of the following appointed officer and employee
of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, be fixed as follows:

SALARY SCHEDULE AS PRESENTED BY
THE BLOOMINGTON COMMON COUNCIL

I, the undersigned, Tomilea Allison, President of the Bloomington
Common Council, as required by Indiana Code 18-2-1-10, do hereby fix
the salary and create the following City of Bloomington employee position
beginning February *12*, 1979, and continuing thereafter until duly changed
and request that such salary rate be approved by the Common Council of said
City, to wit:
