

ORDINANCE 79-33

To Amend Chapter 2.36 of the Bloomington
Municipal Code, Entitled, "Board of Parks and Recreation",
and Create a Special Non-reverting Operating Fund


BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOM-
INGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Chapter 2.36 of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be
amended to add Section 2.36.065 to read as follows:


2.36.065 Special nonreverting operating fund. There is created, to
be under the control of the board of parks and recreation, a special nonre-
verting operating fund, as authorized by IC 19-7-4-26. Moneys in the form
of fees from various activities including concessions shall be deposited at
least once each month with the city controller who shall deposit such moneys
in this fund, but fees from golf courses, swimming pools, skating rinks or
other similar facilities requiring major expenditures for management and main-
tenance shall not be deposited in this fund. Expenditures may be made from
this fund without appropriation, but moneys from this fund shall be disbursed
only on approved claims allowed and signed by the president and secretary of
the board. At the end of each year, the controller shall, if directed by the
board, transfer all or a portion of any surplus moneys in this fund to the
parks and recreation general fund.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and
after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.





deposit income from concessions that the department may operate, and the income
will be used to decrease the amount of tax moneys necessary to operate various
park programs.
