

ORDINANCE 79-57

Salary Ordinance Amendment to Raise the Salaries of Certain
Fleet Maintenance Department Employees

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,
MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. That from and after the 6th day of August, 1979, the salary
and pay schedule of the following appointed officers and employees of the
City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, be fixed as follows:

I, the undersigned, Francis X. McCloskey, Mayor of the City of Bloom-
ington, Monroe County, Indiana, as required by Indiana Code 18-2-1-10 do

31, 1979 and request that such salary rate be approved by the Common Coun-
