ORDINANCE 79-77

To Amend Section 15.68.120, "Designation of City Parking Lots", and To Enact Section 15.68.145, "Downtown Resident Parking Permits", of the Bloomington Municipal Code

- SECTION I. Section 15.68.120 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled "Certain parking lots renamed -- Designation of new lots" shall be amended to read as follows:
- 15.68.120 Certain lots renamed--Designation of new lots. (a) The municipal parking lot located at the northwest corner of East Fourth and Dunn Streets shall be renamed and referred to as Municipal Parking Lot No. 1.
- (b) The municipal parking lot commonly known as the Day Parking Lot located at Seventh and Walnut Streets shall be renamed and referred to as Municipal Parking Lot No. 2.
- (c) The municipal parking lot commonly known as Kerr Parking Lot located at Fourth and Washington Streets shall be renamed and referred to as Municipal Parking Lot No. 3.
- (d) The off-street parking lot located at Fourth and Morton Streets and situated on lots 83 and 84 of the city shall be renamed and referred to as Municipal Parking Lot No. 4.
- (e) The off-street parking lot located at Sixth and Lincoln Streets and situated on lots 185 and 186 of the city shall be renamed and referred to as Municipal Parking Lot No. 5.
- (f) The off-street parking lot located upon part of Fractional Outlot 20, the same being the 200 block of East Third Street, shall be named and referred to as Municipal Parking Lot No. 6.
- (g) The municipal parking lot located at the southwest corner of Seventh Street and College Avenue, commonly known as Park and Shop, and being situated on lots 265 and 266 of the city, shall be renamed and referred to as Municipal Lot No. 7.
- (h) The municipal parking lot located at the northeast corner of Sixth and Morton Streets, commonly known as the Redevelopment Lot, and being situated on lots 221 and 222 of the city, shall be renamed and referred to as Municipal Parking Lot No. 8.
- SECTION II. Section 15.68.145 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled "Downtown resident parking permits," shall be enacted to read as follows:
- 15.68.145 Downtown resident parking permits. (a) Parking privileges shall be made available on a rental basis to all residents of the area on both sides of the streets within one block of the public square. Such residents may obtain permits to park on a regular basis in Municipal Parking Lot Numbers 3, 4, 5, and 7.
- (b) The fee for such permit shall be fifty dollars (\$50) per year, to be paid to the controller, who shall issue the permit upon the completion of an application containing the following:
 - (1) the name and address of the applicant and a signed statement that the applicant resides at the address provided; and
 - (2) the year, make and license number of the applicant's automobile and evidence of valid automobile registration.
- (c) The permit shall be displayed on the lower right-hand corner of the windshield of the vehicle and shall contain the date of expiration. Permits may not be used on any vehicle other than the vehicle for which the permit was issued and the applicant shall notify the controller if the automobile and/or its license number change while the permit is in force.

- (d) Vehicles for which permits have been issued shall be subject to all provisions of the municipal code concerning city parking lots, except that the vehicles shall be exempt from restrictions on the number of hours per day that vehicles may park in the designated parking lots.
- (e) All funds derived from the granting of resident parking permits shall be placed in the city parking meter fund.
- (f) Violations of any provision of this section shall result in revocation of the permit and forfeiture of all fees paid.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
