

ORDINANCE 78-20

To Amend Title 7 of the Bloomington Municipal Code
Entitled "Animals" and Enact a Leash Law


BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 7.01.010 (r) of the Bloomington Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.01.010 (r) "Restraint" means the securing of an animal by a leash or lead or confining it within the real property limits of its owner.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.


