ORDINANCE 78-47

To Provide for the Continuation of Bloomington City Court to 1983

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 33-10.5-1-3a provides that all city courts in cities of the second, third, fourth and fifth class are abolished on December 31, 1979, but that such courts may be continued by an ordinance passed before January 1, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the City Court of Bloomington performs a valuable service for the citizens of Bloomington by providing for efficient, economical and fair dispositions of minor criminal matters; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the citizens of Bloomington to extend the existence of the Bloomington City Court until December 31, 1983;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. The City Court of Bloomington is hereby continued for a period of four years, up to and including December 31, 1983, as provided in Indiana Code 33-10.5-1-3a (P.L. 141, Acts 1978, Section 9).

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
