# Salary Ordinance for Elected and Appointed Officers and Employees of City Clerk and Court for 1979

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOM-INGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:
