## To Amend the Salary Ordinance for 1978

According to State law, the maximum salaries of all City employees must be fixed annually by the first day of August for the following year. If there is a new postion created during the year, the original salary ordinance must be amended to include it.

This ordinance amends the original salary ordinance passed last year in August. It creates the new position of SYSTEMS & PROCEDURE ANALYST, and sets the maximum pay for that position at \$15,500.
