ORDINANCE 78-76

To Amend Section 2.02.040 of the Bloomington Municipal Code
Entitled, Appointments-Residency Requirement for City Boards and Commissions

WHEREAS, the purpose of the requirement that appointees to City boards and Commissions be City residents was that they would better represent the interests of the citizens of Bloomington than would non-resident appointees, and

WHEREAS, City employees serving on boards and commissions are also likely to represent the interests of the residents of Bloomington both vigorously and carefully, and

WHEREAS, some City boards and commissions require that appointees be City employees,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:


SECTION I. Section 2.02.040 of the Bloomington Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

Section 2.02.040 Appointments--Residential Requirement.
All appointments to city boards and commissions shall be made from persons who, at the time of their appointment, are either residents and/or employees of the city except those positions on boards and commissions that are specifically required or allowed by state law or city ordinance to be made from persons who are not residents and/or employees of the city of Bloomington.

SECTION II. Severability. If any section, sentence or provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions, or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.


