

RESOLUTION 78-5

To Appoint Milton Mitnick, State Director of Civil  
Defense, as Applicant Agent for Federal Emergency Assistance

WHEREAS, the severe weather of January 25 to January 30, 1978 imposed serious strains on the City of Bloomington Street Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington incurred costs above and beyond those that normally arise from snow removal, and


WHEREAS, President Jimmy Carter has designated Indiana eligible for Federal Emergency Assistance; and

WHEREAS, In order for the City of Bloomington to receive assistance, an agent who will serve as liaison between the City and Federal Government must be appointed,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

Milton Mitnick is hereby authorized to execute for and on the behalf of the City of Bloomington, a project application and to file in the appropriate state office for the purpose of obtaining certain federal financial assistance under the Disaster Relief Act (Public Law 288, 93rd Congress), or otherwise available from the President's Disaster Relief Fund.

SYNOPSIS

RESOLUTION 78-5

To Appoint Milton Mitnick, State Director of Civil  
Defense, as Applicant Agent for Federal Emergency Assistance

The City of Bloomington has suffered substantial hardship from the recent severe weather. President Carter has issued an Emergency Assistance Declaration for the state which makes Bloomington eligible for federal financial assistance. In order for the City to receive assistance, an agent must be appointed to serve as liaison with the federal government. The State Civil Defense Director, Milton Mitnick, will serve in that capacity for all Indiana municipalities. A formal resolution of the Bloomington Common Council appointing an applicant agent is a prerequisite for reimbursement.
