## ORDINANCE 77-1

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAPS, DATED JUNE 22, 1973

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 21, 1973, and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Ordinance and maps are now incorporated in the Bloomington Municipal Code as Title 20 of said Code, and

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission has considered this case ZO-45-76 and recommended said Bloomington zoning maps be amended by the rezoning of certain property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, that under the authority of Chapter 174 of the 1947 Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana as amended that the property commonly known as 1817 Maxwell/be rezoned from RS <u>Residential</u> <u>Single Family</u> to RL <u>Residential</u> Low Density.

SECTION 1. That the incorporated map number 13, of June 22, 1973, be amended to rezone the following described land as follows, to-wit:

Lot 69 and part of Lot 70, Huntington Park

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.

SYNOPSIS ORDINANCE 77-1 (PLAN COMMISSION CASE NO. ZO-45-76) NOVEMBER 22, 1976

The Zoning Ordinance classifies all land within the planning jurisdiction into residential, business, and manufacturing zones. The boundries for these zones are established by the Plan Commission and Common Council and within each district only certain uses are permitted.

This ordinance will change the zoning from RS <u>Residential Single Family</u> to RL <u>Residential Low Density</u> for a tract of land located at 1817 Maxwell *STREET*.

This rezoning will allow an already newly built structure to be used as a two-family dwelling unit.
