ORDINANCE 77-18

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAPS, DATED JUNE 22, 1973

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 21, 1973, and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Ordinance and maps are now incorporated in the Bloomington Municipal Code as Title 20 of said Code, and

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission has considered this case ZO-9-77 and recommended said Bloomington zoning maps be amended by the rezoning of certain property, and

WHEREAS, petitioner Lloyd Gilham requests that the Common Council of the City of Bloomington consider this petition for the rezoning of said property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

Under the authority of Chapter 174 of the 1947 Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, as amended, that the property commonly known as 719 W. Kirkwood Avenue be rezoned from RM <u>Residential Medium Density</u> to BL <u>Limited</u> Business.

SECTION I. The incorporated map number 6, of June 22, 1973, be amended to rezone the following described land as follows, towit:

Waldron Addition, part of Lot 15.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
