SYNOPSIS

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 77-4

To Appropriate Funds from the Federal Revenue Sharing Trust Fund and Public Works Title II Fund to Transit Dept.

This ordinance appropriates funds in the amount of \$63,866 for operating expenses of the Transit Department and \$36,000 for casualty insurance for the transit operation over and above what was budgeted for in 1977. The source of funds is Federal Revenue Sharing and Title II of the Public Works Employment Fund.

The second title of the Public Works bill allotted to local governments allowed monies to be dispersed over four quarters according to the General Revenue Sharing formula and the local employment rate. The City of Bloomington has received payment for three quarters, the first \$24,976, the second \$10,439. The third has been announced at \$2,511 and the fourth, to be paid in April, is unnanounced.

Title II funds must be used for existing city services, making its use for the transit system appropriate.
