

ORDINANCE 76-25

To Amend Title 7 of the Bloomington  
Municipal Code Entitled "Animals"

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

SECTION I. Section 7.12.040 Fees be amended to read as follows:

A license shall be issued after payment of the applicable fees and the receipt of all application materials. Per year fees shall be as follows:

- (a) for each unneutered male or unspayed female dog or cat . . . . \$5.00
- (b) for each neutered male and spayed female dog or cat . . . . . \$ .50

A duplicate license may be obtained for a fee of \$.25 upon the owner's certifying that the original tag is lost...

(The remainder of this section is to remain unchanged)

SECTION II. Section 7.24.020 Animals in Heat be amended to read as follows:

Every female animal in heat shall be confined in a building or secure enclosure in such a manner that the animal cannot come into contact with a male animal of the same species except for planned breeding.

SECTION III. Section 7.32.030 Notice of Impoundment-Reclaiming be amended to read as follows in the last sentence:

Any owner reclaiming an impounded animal other than a dog or cat shall pay a board fee and daily charge in keeping with the size and needed care of the animal.

SECTION IV. Section 7.40.010 Keeping Wild Animals be amended to read as follows:

No person shall keep or permit to be kept on his premises any wild or vicious animal for any purpose, except as provided in 7.40.020. This section shall not be construed to apply to zoological parks, circuses, performing animal exhibitions or research laboratories.

SECTION V. Sections 7.24.040 Violation, 7.44.050 Violation, and 7.48.020 Violation, be amended to increase the fines in those sections to \$100.

SECTION VI. Section 7.28.020 Discharging Excrement Prohibited - Violation be deleted in its entirety.

SECTION VII. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.






