ORDINANCE 76-63

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAPS, DATED JUNE 22, 1973

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 21, 1973, and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Ordinance and maps are now incorporated in the Bloomington Municipal Code as Title 20 of said Code, and

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission has considered this case ZO-34-76 and recommended said Bloomington zoning maps be amended by the rezoning of certain property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, that under the authority of Chapter 174 of the 1947 Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana as amended that the property commonly known as a tract of land located in the 2700 Block of Vernal Pike be rezoned from RL <u>Residential Low Density</u> and ML <u>Light Manufacturing</u> to ML Light Manufacturing.

SECTION 1. That the unincorporated map number 6, of June 22, 1973, be amended to rezone the following described land as follows, to-wit:

Lots 3, 4, and 5 in the Town of Hensonburg, being a subdivision of a part of the Northeast quarter of Section 31, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, EXCEPTING THEREFROM the following: A part of Lots 4 and 5 in the Town of Hensonburg, Indiana, the plat of which is recorded in Plat Book 2 page 20 in the office of the Recorder of Monroe County, Indiana, described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Lot 5, thence Southwesterly 41.48 feet along the Eastern line of said Lot 5, thence Northwesterly 18.95 feet along an arc to the left and having a radius of 120.99 feet and subtended by a chord having a bearing of North 61° 41' 17" West and a length of 18.93 feet, thence North 69° 10' 30" West 35.90 feet, thence North 41° 06' 09" West 85 feet to the Northern line of said Lot 4, thence Southeasterly 129.99 feet along the Northern line of said Lots 4 and 5 to the point of beginning and containing 3700 square feet, more or less. ALSO, Lots 6 and 7 in the Town of Hensonburg, being a subdivision of a part of the Northeast quarter of Section 31, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, EXCEPTING THEREFROM the following: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Lot 7, thence Southeast corner of said Lot 7, thence North-westerly 170.00 feet along the Eastern line of said Lot 7 to the Southeast corner of said Lot 7, thence North-westerly 31.22 feet along an arc to the left and having a radius of 120.99 feet and subtended by a long chord having a bearing of North 17° 33' 06" West and a length of 163.94 feet to the Western line of said Lot 6, thence Southeasterly 133.00 feet along the North-west corner of said Lot 6, thence Southeasterly 133.00 feet along the North-west corner of said Lot 6, thence Southeasterly 133.00 feet along the North-west line of said Lot 6, thence Southeasterly 133.00 feet along the North-west line of said Lot 6, thence Southeasterly 133.00 feet along the North-west corner of said Lot 6, thence Southeasterly 133.00 feet along the North-west line of said Lot 6, thence Southeasterly 133.00 feet along

SYNOPSIS ORDINANCE 76-63 (PLAN COMMISSION CASE NO. Z0-34-76) AUGUST 25, 1976

The Zoning Ordinance classifies all land within the planning jurisdiction into residential, business, and manufacturing zones. The boundaries for these zones are established by the Plan Commission and Common Council and within each district only certain uses are permitted.

This ordinance will change the zoning for a parcel of land located in the 2700 block of Vernal Pike from RL <u>Residential Low Density</u> and ML <u>Light</u> Manufacturing to ML Light Manufacturing.
