

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE CUMULATIVE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget; NOW THEREFORE:

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, that for the expenses of said municipal corporation the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the fund herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same, to wit: CUMULATIVE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND:

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 76-10


To Appropriate Funds to Renovate the Carnegie Library

This ordinance requests the appropriation of \$121,000 from the Cumulative Capital Improvement Fund for renovation of the Monroe County Carnegie Library. The money requested would cover "Phase I" of the renovation project, to include heating and cooling, exterior repairs and renovation of the basement area. It is anticipated that an appropriation for "Phase II" will be requested for 1977.

The basement area of the facility will be used as an interim location for City Court. Completion of "Phase II" will make space available on a lease basis to community cultural groups.
