## SYNOPSIS

## APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 76-13

## AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE LOCAL ROAD AND STREET FUND

Under state law, no money can be spent by the City without authorization from the Council in the form of an appropriation ordinance. Since the monies covered by this ordinance were not part of the budget for 1976 passed last August, they must now be approved by the Council if they are to be spent.

Local Road & Street money is predited to the City, but cannot be drawn until several steps are taken. The City must formulate a major street project, arrange for a 10% local match, submit plans and specifications and recieve approval from the Arterial Road Board, let contracts through the Board of Public Works, and appropriate the monies for the project through the City Council. All but the last step have been taken on Project # 7.

Project # 7 is the improvement of Smith Road from 3rd to 10th Streets.
