

ORDINANCE NO. 75-32

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 17 OF THE
BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED,
" BUILDING REGULATIONS"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:


SECTION 1. The Bloomington Municipal Code is hereby
amended by adding thereto Section 17.04.250 which shall read as
follows:

17.04.250 Appliances installed in residential garages

Appliances generating a flame, glow or spark
capable of igniting flammable vapors which are located
in the garage of one (1) or two (2) family dwelling units
must be installed so that the section or component generating
the flame, glow or spark is at least eighteen (18) inches
above the floor. The City Engineering Department is charged
with the responsibility of enforcing this section and is to
determine whether or not the appliances have been properly
installed. This section shall not apply to devices presently
in operation or to replacements thereof.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and
effect six months after its passage, promulgation and publication
in accordance with the law.

Bloomington, Indiana, on the 3 day of July, 1975.






