ORDINANCE NO. 75-58

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

> A part of the southwest quarter of Section 28, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning in the center of a public highway, known as Faris Lane Pike, leading northeast from the State Highway #37, near the end of the concrete boulevard at a point 9 rods south of the north line of said quarter section, running thence east 20 rods, thence north 9 rods to the north line of said quarter section, thence west along said north line, and along a highway on said north line to a point where said highway leaves said north line, thence southwest along said highway to the place of beginning, and located in Monroe County, Indiana.

Also, a part of the southwest quarter of Section 28, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, commencing in the center of State Road 37 at a point 9 rods south of the north line of said quarter section, running thence east 20 rods, thence running south $7\frac{1}{2}$ rods, thence west 20 rods to the center of State Highway #37, thence north along the center of said Highway to the place of beginning.

Also, a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section Twenty-Eight (28), Township Nine (9) North, Range One (1) West, in Monroe County, State of Indiana, bounded and described as follows, towit: Beginning at a point on the north line of said quarter Seventy-Five (75) rods and Sixteen and Three Tenths (16.3) feet West of the Northeast corner thereof, thence South four (4) chains and ten and seven tenths (10.7) links, thence West one hundred sixty-four and four tenths (164.4) feet; thence North to the North line of said quarter; thence east one hundred sixty-four and four tenths (164.4) feet to the place of beginning, containing one (1) acre, more or less.

The above description is land lying at the southeast corner of State Road 37 and State Road 46 and will be the site of a neighborhood shopping center. SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
