SALARY ORDINANCE FOR BLOOMINGTON UTILITY EMPLOYEES

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF UTILITY EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, FOR THE YEAR 1976.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the resolution of the Utilities Service Board of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, the salary and pay schedule for the employees of the said Board from and after the first day of January, 1976, shall be as follows:

SHIFT DIFFERENTIAL

Employees working on the evening or night shift shall receive a 10¢ (ten cent) per hour shift premium. Employees working on a swing shift shall receive a 15¢ (fifteen cent) per hour shift differential.

INCENTIVE PAY

Personnel in the ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT, TREATMENT OPERATIONS, UTILITIES TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION, and METER SERVICES sections who achieve state certification, but are in non-operator classifications, shall receive a $10 \, \phi$ (ten cent) per hour incentive pay premium.

* TREATMENT OPERATORS

Treatment plant operators must have the license for the classification they hold.

^{**} These two positions are supervisory in nature and are equivalent to position of Assistant Superintendent in other departments.

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SECTION 2. The rates as wages and salaries for the positions as listed above are the maximum rates.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approved by the Mayor.
