TASK FORCE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington, Indiana has established a Department of Human Resources aimed at supplementing the provision of community services, when such supplementation is appropriate, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington, Indiana Department of Human Resources is available to all public and private community service agencies for the purpose of providing technical assistance and to stimulate community-wide cooperation and sharing of information and expertise, and

WHEREAS, there is great community concern in selecting the most qualified individual to fulfill the job description set out in the Ordinance establishing said Department.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION I: That a Human Resources Task Force entitled: Director Search and Screen Task Force, be created to provide the Mayor of the City of Bloomington with recommendations as to the five (5) most qualified applicants for the position of Director of Human Resources.


SECTION II: That said Task Force shall make recommendations to the Mayor of the City of Bloomington, Indiana by March 27, 1975.

SECTION III: That said Task Force shall consist of seven (7) members of which four (4) members shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City of Bloomington and that three (3) members shall be appointed by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.
