

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 75-16

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING MONIES TO MEET
EXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCY FOUND TO EXIST.

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary emergencies have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated for the year 1975; NOW, THEREFORE:

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, that for the expenses of said municipal corporation, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND, subject to the law governing the same, to-wit



PASSED and ADOPTED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, this 4 day of December, 1975.






