## SALARY ORDINANCE FOR APPOINTED EMPLOYEES

AN ORDINANCE FIXING SALARIES OF APPOINTED EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, FOR THE YEAR 1974

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, THAT
