

ORDINANCE NO. 74-44

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, more specifically described as follows, to-
wit:

Windermere Addition as platted in
Book 3, page 2, in the Monroe County
Recorder's Office, Bloomington, Indiana.

Said above land lying in the Windermere
Addition.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries
of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby
declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate
hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor
and publication in accordance with the law.
