

ORDINANCE NO. 74-91

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION  
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

Parts of the Southwest quarter of the North-east quarter of Section 10, Township 8 North, Range 1 West, bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point in the center of the pike road running North and South through said Section, said starting point is 151½ feet North of the center of said Section; thence South 83 degrees East, 326 feet to a stone; thence South 45 degrees East, 201 feet to the half section line; running East and West through said Section; thence North 12 degrees East, 76 feet to a Sycamore tree; thence North 63 degrees West, 176 feet; thence North 88 degrees West, 326 feet to the center of the road; thence South 12½ feet to the place of beginning, containing one-half acre, more or less.

And commencing at the center of said Section 10, said starting point is in the center of the pike road that runs North and South through said section; thence North with the meanderings of said road 153 feet; thence a little Southeast 329 feet to a point 131 feet North of the half section line, running East and West through said section; thence South 45 degrees East 193 feet to the East and West half Section line; thence West on the half Section line 470 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1¼ acres. more or less.

The above description describes properties lying East of South High Street North of Meadowbluff Court and owned by Burl Webb.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
